To All Residents,

The stay at home order issued by the Governor's office will shut down all businesses in Ohio deemed non-essential, effective at midnight tonight. I sent a list of businesses that are deemed essential earlier today. This order remains in effect through April 6, 2020, to attempt to stop the spread of the Covid-19 virus. It remains to be seen as to how long this order will extend beyond early April.

Village Hall will remain open with limited hours (yet to be determined) but is closed to walk in traffic. The Administrative staff is working the minimum in order to keep our government operating. The Building Department is closed to walk in traffic. The Mayor's court window at Village Hall will be open on a limited basis. The Community Center remains closed. These hours will be posted at www.bratenahl.org.

Police and Service are deemed essential and will work. EMS and Fire services are essential as well.

We will limit interaction with the public as much as possible. All Village meetings are postponed, except for a quick Council meeting next Wednesday.

I ask that all take this order from the Governor to heart. We must "flatten the curve" and save as many lives as possible.
